## **FALLS CREEK CAMPER SAFETY ZERO-TOLERANCE POLICY**

Falls Creek is committed to a positive, uplifting, Christian environment. Falls Creek does not tolerate and expressly prohibits sexual harassment and sexual abuse. This policy applies to everyone at Falls Creek, including employees, board members, volunteers, leaders, campers, contractors, and vendors of Falls Creek.

### **Rule Reminders**

According to the Cell Phone Policy the Student Ministry released in January 2020, Cell Phones will NOT be allowed at Falls Creek. Phones need to be left at home. (Must provide Doctor's Note if phone is needed for medical reasons)

- Students can take naps during the allotted time each day (3-4pm)
- Students are not allowed to enter the cabin of another church for any reason.
- Students must travel in groups of at least three.
- Every student must be on time to every activity.
- Every student must participate in worship services, in-cabin sessions, cabin devotions, and quiet times.
- Every student must eat something substantial at all meals.
- Every student must do their part in KP, Bathroom, and Dorm Duty.
- Pranks, Rock Throwing, Water Fighting, etc. are NOT allowed.
- No skates or skateboards on the campus unless it is in the skate park.
- No Public Display of Affection.

## ***QUAIL STUDENTS' MEDICATION POLICY***

- Quail Students will have medicine bags filled with first aid supplies as well as basic medicines as pain and allergy medicines.
- All medicine (including allergy, ibuprofen, etc.) and vitamins, or supplements/etc. must be turned in.
- If your student is bringing medicine:
  - You will fill out form at check in with detailed instructions
  - Bring medicine to check in with the original bottle with prescription label attached
    - We will not accept any medicine that is not in the original bottle with correct labels
  - Write specific times (breakfast, lunch, dinner, bedtime) on what days they will need to be taken.
- We will have designated leaders with medical background and experience, that will be distributing them throughout the week.
- Communicate with your students to look for our medical leaders at the time they are needing their medications for the day (meals/bedtime, etc.)
- Even if you believe your student will need ibuprofen or allergy medicine, etc.; you will need to turn those in with instructions
- After check in, and before we get on the bus for camp, we will have a meeting with our medical leaders and all students who are needing medicine for the week, so they can know who they are looking for while at camp for their medications

## **Dress Code Reminders**

While we understand the desire for fashionable attire, we require you to wear modest clothing. Modesty is a biblical principle and helps keep people focused on the important things at camp. (1 Timothy 2:9-10; 4:12)

All apparel judgments will be left to the discretion of the Falls Creek Staff (FCS). If FCS determines a camper or campers should change their clothing to fall in line with camp requirements, then said camper or campers are required to do so.

- Modesty is very important and required.
- Shoes must always be worn outside of your cabin.
- Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.
- Under garments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. No boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).
- Midriffs should always be covered.
- No spaghetti strap shirts or dresses.
- No tank tops. All apparel must cover the shoulder. Sleeveless shirts are acceptable but must go from the neck to the shoulder seam and not be split down the side.
- No short shorts. Shorts are to be of modest length. (Modest length can be generally defined as extending to just beyond the fingertips, which is generally no shorter than a 5" to 7" inseam.)
- No tight fitting and revealing clothing. This includes leggings, jeggings, Spanx, compression shorts, yoga pants or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.
- Girls may wear dresses/skirts, but they must reach the top of the knee. Dresses must have an accessory to wear under or over any straps that do not cover the complete shoulder.
- Girls should wear modest one-piece swimsuits. Males should not wear tight fitting swimming suits.
- While going to and from the swimming areas, all campers must wear shoes; males must wear a t-shirt and females must wear a long covering over their swimming suits.
- Shoes, T-shirt or long covering must be worn when going to and from swimming.

## **Consequences**

- Late to any Falls Creek activity or Miss KP, Dorm, or Bathroom Duty – First offense is automatic extra KP, Dorm, OR Bathroom Duty. Second offense is loss of free time. Third offense is a parent is called to come pick up student.
- Failure to abide by cell phone policy results in loss of free time for one day. Staff will confiscate phone, and parents will have to recover cell phone during office hours from the Student Ministry Staff the Monday-Friday following camp.
- Pranks, messing with people's belongings, stealing, sneaking out, and fighting result in an automatic phone call to parents to come pick up student.
- Failure to travel in at least groups of 3 – first offense is loss of free time. If this rule is broken twice, automatic send home.
- Public Display of Affection – first offense is loss of free time. If this rule is broken twice, automatic send home.
- Dress Code Violations – first time offense is a warning and change of clothes, second offense is loss of free time privileges for the day and change of clothes.
- Disrespect to staff/leaders and failure to abide by rules – first time offense is loss of free time, second offense is a call to parents to be sent home

## **Miscellaneous Important Information**

- Extra Spending money is suggested for each student who attends Falls Creek. Pop, Ice Cream, Icees, T-shirts, devotionals, student planners, merchandise from worship band and speaker, and gift items are available to campers all week. \$30 to \$40 dollars is the recommended amount.
